Meeting introductions and objectives

This is the second of two technical expert meetings in the lead up to the [Climate Action Pacific Partnership Conference](#) taking place on 13 and 14 May in Suva. The meeting of CAPP technical experts is to prepare for the Third CAPP Conference (CAPPIII), with a specific focus on the conference sessions 5 and 6. The meetings bring together CAPP thematic experts from different agencies, including government agencies (and national climate change focal points), private sector, civil society organisations and regional and international development partners.

On the first day, technical experts will prepare thematic presentations on current climate action plans and/or plans currently in development. The presentations will also reflect how the action plans will contribute towards the enhancement and/or the implementation of NDCs. These presentations will be presented on Day 2, session 5 at CAPPIII.

The second day (morning) will focus on preparations for CAPPIII session 6 – preparing for the UN Climate Summit in September 2019. This will include a presentation on the Summit and criteria for the Pacific to contribute in the Summit. The meeting will identify impactful and innovative climate actions taken by Pacific SIDS that can be considered for showcasing at the UN Climate Summit, including the announcement of enhanced NDCs.
